
SAFETY & WARNINGS

- Read all instructions before using the appliance and retain this user guide for future reference.
- Unplug the monitor before cleaning it.
- Use a clean, slightly-dampened cloth to wipe the main monitor body.
- To clean the screen: turn it off, unplug it and wait for it to cool completely, then wipe it with a dry microfibre cloth.
- Do not use cleaning alcohol, ammonia-based liquids or other harsh cleaners.
- This monitor is designed with ventilation holes on the back of the casing. Do not cover or block them.
- Do not insert any object or spray any liquid into the vents.
- Avoid placing the monitor near heaters, stoves, fireplaces or other sources of heat, as well as in rooms lacking adequate ventilation.
- Do not position the monitor in unsafe locations. If the monitor falls, it may be damaged and may injure nearby people.
- Unplug the monitor if it is not going to be used for an extended period.
- Do not place heavy objects on the monitor, its power cord or any connected cable.
- Do not open the back panel of the monitor, as it contains a high-voltage current even when not plugged in.





OVERVIEW

Monitor Controls



- 1 Arrow Press to turn the display backlight on/off.
- 2 \equiv Menu button Press to display the OSD menu or enter sub-menus.
- $\mathbf{3}$ \lor Down button Press to move down in the menu.
- 4 ^ Up button Press to move up in the menu.
- 5 ¹ Exit button Press to exit the menu.
- 6 \bigcirc Power button Press to turn the monitor ON/OFF.

- 8 VGA input
- 9 HDMI input
- 10 Power input


ASSEMBLY

Before disposing of any packaging, place all items on a soft, clean and flat surface to ensure all components are accounted for.


WARNING: The panel of the monitor is fragile. Keep the foam underneath the monitor screen while assembling the stand.




1. Carefully remove the monitor, stand arm and stand base from the box.



 Insert the stand arm block into the back cabinet and push down until firmly connected.



2. Attach the stand base to the stand arm using the M4x16 screw provided.




4. Lift the monitor up straight and remove the bottom foam. Stand the monitor up on the installed base.

VESA MOUNT




VESA mounting pattern 100 x 100mm, screw size M4. Note: VESA mount or mounting accessories are **NOT** included.

Open the box, take out the monitor with protection form attached and gently place it on a desktop or table. Remove the extra parts and the foam covering the back of the monitor. Press the release button to remove the stand plate. If the monitor was already attached to the stand assembly, remove it.




Assemble the mount following the instructions provided with the mount.



CONNECTIVITY


Power

Connect the included power cable to the monitor power port, then connect the other end to a power outlet.




Audio In

Connect an audio cable to the 3.5mm audio port on the monitor (Audio In) and the 3.5mm audio port on your computer.




HDMI

Connect an HDMI cable from the computer's display output to the monitor's display input.



VGA


Connect a VGA cable from the computer's display output to the monitor's display input.



- 1. Connect the monitor to the input device via HDMI or VGA.
- **2.** Connect the power cable to the monitor, then connect the other end directly to a power socket.
- **3.** Use the power button to turn the monitor on.

Indicator Light

The indicator light will illuminate green when the monitor is powered on.



FreeSync

- In order to use this feature, ensure your hardware has FreeSync capability and the graphics drivers are fully up to date.
- After connecting, you may receive a prompt to enable the feature on your computer. If you do not receive the prompt, you may need to enable the function in your graphics card menu.
- See your graphics card manufacturer's documentation for instructions on how to turn on and/or enable FreeSync.

The On-Screen Display (OSD)

The OSD menu may be used to adjust your monitor's settings and appears on screen after turning on the monitor and pressing the " \equiv " button.

When using the monitor for the first time, settings will automatically adjust to optimal parameters according to your computer's configuration and parts etc.

- 1. Press " \equiv " to enter the OSD menu.
- 2. Press " \checkmark " or " \land " to browse functions.

With the desired function highlighted, press " \equiv " to enter the sub-menu.

Press " \checkmark " or " \land " to browse sub-menus, then press " \equiv " to highlight the desired function.

Press " \lor " or " \land " to highlight an option, then press " \equiv " to confirm the settings and exit the current screen.

3. Press " \mathcal{D} " to exit the current screen.


